**APPROVING SUPPORT OF GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL COMMISSION
SMART SCALE PRIORITY PROJECTS**

WHEREAS, the George Washington Regional Commission (“the Commission”) serves as Planning District for PDC 16, and;

WHEREAS, the Commission is an eligible agency to submit project applications for 2016 Smart Scale funding consideration in the FY 18-23 Six Year Improvement Program (SYIP), and;

WHEREAS, the Commission member jurisdiction staff have met with GWRC/FAMPO staff several times during the May to September, 2016 timeframe to develop regional Smart Scale` priority projects for GWRC and FAMPO and have identified five potential regional projects with three scheduled for submission by GWRC and two by FAMPO, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the George Washington Regional Commission that it hereby authorizes staff to submit the following three projects to the State by September 30, 2016 for Smart Scale funding consideration in the FY 18-23 SYIP:

1. VRE Brooke and Leeland Station Improvements (Stafford)
2. New commuter parking lot on Kings Hwy (Rte 3) (Stafford)
3. Twin Lake/Kensington Bicycle & Pedestrian Connector (Lafayette Blvd in Fredericksburg)
