

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-05**

**GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL COMMISSION SUPPORT OF KING GEORGE  
COUNTY REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM REQUEST FOR ITS KING GEORGE MIDDLE  
SCHOOL TURN LANES PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the George Washington Regional Commission (“the Commission”) is the Planning District Commission serving the City of Fredericksburg and Caroline, King George, Spotsylvania and Stafford counties, known collectively as Planning District 16, and;

**WHEREAS**, King George County is applying for \$316,000 in fiscal year 2019 Revenue Sharing Program funding from the Virginia Department of Transportation for its King George Middle School Turn Lanes Project (\$158,000 in Revenue Sharing funds with a \$158,000 (50%) required local match); and

**WHEREAS**, the King George Middle School Turn Lanes Project consists of the closing and removal of the southern entrance to the King George County Middle School located on Route 206 (Dahlgren Road), improving the northern entrance on Route 206 (Dahlgren Road) to conform with commercial entrance design standards, and the construction of turn lanes for the proposed improved entrance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission Committee believes that the intended project is worthwhile and , and would be of general benefit to the Region;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL COMMISSION THAT KING GEORGE COUNTY’S REVENUE SHARING PROGRAM REQUEST FOR ITS KING GEORGE MIDDLE SCHOOL TURN LANES PROJECT IS HEREBY ENDORSED.**
