

RESOLUTION NO. 18-06

RECOGNIZING THE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE OF JAMES B. HOWARD

WHEREAS, the George Washington Regional Commission (“the Commission”) is the Planning District Commission serving the City of Fredericksburg and Caroline, King George, Spotsylvania and Stafford counties, known collectively as Planning District 16, and;

WHEREAS, James B. Howard has a long history of service to King George County, including as a volunteer for numerous not-for-profit organizations, as a member of the King George School Board and as James Monroe District Supervisor on the King George County Board of Supervisors, and;

WHEREAS, James B. Howard served for thirteen years as a Commissioner of the Rappahannock Area Development Commission and the George Washington Regional Commission; and;

WHEREAS, James B. Howard assumed a leading role in the development of both the “Strategic Plan for the George Washington Regional Commission” and the “Amended and Restated Charter Agreement of the George Washington Regional Commission”, which have been widely credited for reinvigorating the Commission since their adoption in 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the George Washington Regional Commission that it expresses its deepest appreciation and most sincere thanks to James B. Howard for his long, dedicated and distinguished service to Planning District 16.
