

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-21**

**AUTHORIZING SUPPORT FOR THE GEORGE WASHINGTON REGIONAL COMMISSION  
SMART SCALE PROJECT APPLICATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the George Washington Regional Commission (“the Commission”) serves as the Planning District Commission for PD 16; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commonwealth of Virginia is accepting Smart Scale project applications from March 1, 2018 through July 31, 2018 for the Fiscal Year 2020-2025 Six-Year Improvement Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission is eligible to submit up to four project applications for Smart Scale; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission’s member-jurisdiction staff have met with GWRC/FAMPO staff several times from January to May 2018 to develop regional Smart Scale priority projects, and have identified eight potential regional projects with four scheduled to be submitted by GWRC and four by FAMPO;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the George Washington Regional Commission that it hereby authorizes staff to submit the following projects for Smart Scale funding consideration in the Fiscal Year 2020-2025 Six-Year Improvement Program:

1. I-95 Exit 136 interchange improvements and Enon Road improvements (Stafford County);
2. US 17 Business STARS Study improvements and new US 17 Business park and ride lot (Stafford County);
3. Route 3 STARS Study improvements and Exit 130 interchange improvements (City of Fredericksburg); and
4. Route 3 STARS Study improvements, Exit 130 interchange improvements, and Gateway Boulevard extension from Route 3 to Cowan Boulevard (City of Fredericksburg).

Adopted by the George Washington Regional Commission at its duly called meeting of June 18, 2018, in the City of Fredericksburg, Virginia, a quorum being present.
